

Patio & Garden Pebble Fountain Installation Instructions

- Firstly, to install the pebble fountain tub, dig a hole approximately 5cm deeper than the tub itself. Line prepared hole with 3cm of sand. The top of the tub should be 2cm below ground level. Using a spirit level ensure that the top of the tub is level.
- Place the top of the pebble pool onto the tub, and press down to mark out the circumference and planting pockets. Remove top and dig out marked surface area 2cm below ground level and planting pockets.
- When you are ready to install the pool, place the pump into the tub and use the pump's fountain riser (nozzle pipes) to bring the fountain head above the pebble pond (you may need to place the pump on something to raise it higher). Lead the cable over the outer rim of the tub and then place the pebble pond top onto the tub.
- To install the pump, you will require an electrical supply. Pay close attention to the electrical safety advice and instructions supplied by the pump manufacturer. If you have any doubts regarding the installation of the pump, consult a qualified electrician. Always ensure that necessary measures have been made to protect live electrical cable.
- Dress the pebble pond top with plants in pockets, use marginal pond plants or moisture loving plants, low trailing plants are best and washed stones of your choice. Then, simply fill your pebble fountain with water, turn on and enjoy.

Installation Tips :-

- Test out the fountain flow before top dressing your pebble pool. This will save time dismantling if the flow is too high or low.
- If you are dressing your feature with large cobbles, it may be advisable to sit the reservoir tub and the pebble top further into the ground than the 2cm suggested. This will prevent the cobbles looking too perched up and more in level with the surround.
